






to practice before the shows.**




**Waza can stretch to become a string,  
this helps the violin sing.**




**The bow tickles as it crosses Waza's belly.**

vibrate a lovely melody.**





**By a movement of his hand,

**He would send the notes into vibrato.**


**At the show, the audience sits and listens.**




Cheers and applause come at the end.
